LAND USE PLAN UPDATE PUBLIC FORUM MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Picerno called the meeting to order.

1. WELCOME

5. NEXT STEPS

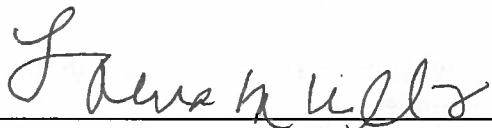
